admin_logger

1. Overview

Admin Logger is a Magento extension designed to log every changes made on Magento Back office such as product, category, taxes creation, changes or deletion.

Each action is logged with data and user.

2. Installation

WARNING :

Before files upload, **ENABLE MAGENTO CACHE** : this will prevent Magento to try to install extension before all files are uploaded.

Also, if you have any :

- APC cache
- Redis cache
- Memcache
- Activated the Compilation of Magento

-> **Please disable them**

Open the file "app/etc/local.xml" and check for / switch off any other extra caches.

You just need to upload this file structure to your server on the same file structure provided by Magento.

No code file will be erase : All the code files will be available into /app/code/community/MDN

Once all files are copied, please follow here under steps to make sure it is well installed:

Refresh cache (System menu > Cache settings): If you get any error message at this stage, it means that there are some problems with the installation.

Refresh indexes (System > Index management)

Disconnect and reconnect yourself from Magento's back office.

Upload files

Unzip the archive and upload it into your remote web site.

Once all files are uploaded, you have to refresh both magento and index caches.

Once caches are refreshed, log out and login from admin panel (to reset permissions).

3. Configuration

All settings are available from menu System > Configuration > Advanced > Admin Logger

Note

if you have "Access denied" message, you have to logout and login from admin panel to reset permissions

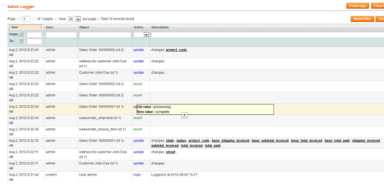
Setting	Description
Enable	Yes / No
Prune	If activate prune the logs from the specified date
Prune delay	Number of day before prune (delete logs)
Force initial data	Allow maximum information in logs for more details

4. How to use

To view logs, select menu "System > Admin logger"



The table logs contain this following informations :

setting	description
data	Action date
user	User who made the changes
object	Target object which has been changed
action	Action type (insert, delete, update ...)
description	Action description (summarize changes)

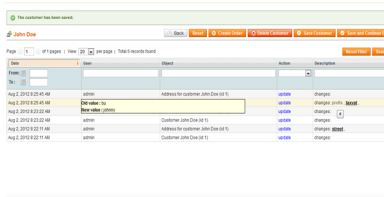
Note

you move your cursor on the medicated value of column description, to view a popup that contain old and new value for comparison.

You can also prune logs by clicking button "Prune logs", or delete all logs by clicking "Clear logs"

1. Admin logger - customer

To view customer logs go into " Customer ", select a customer and click on the tab " admin logger " :




The table logs contain this following informations :

setting	description
date	Action date
user	User who made the changes
object	Target object which has been changed
action	Action type (insert, delete, update ...)
description	Action description (summarize changes)

Notice : when you move your cursor on the modified value it displays information about older and newer value.

The number of logs displayed is 100, when this value is overpassing please prune logs.

5. Prune




The displayed list contains the following columns:

paramètre	description
date	action date
user	user which do the action
object	the modified object
action	type : insert, update, delete
description	the description of the action

5. Prune

Load shedding is to clear all the logs X days, so as not asphyxiated's journal log. Instead, please enable it and set the load shedding period, in "system", "configuration" admin log ".



You can also delete the logs spontaneously without having to activate the load shedding.

For appointment in this "system", "admin log" then click "Prune logs".
